A Praise Confession

Deuteronomy 31:6: **Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the LORD thy God, he *it is* that doth go with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.**

Psalms 9: 9, 10: **The LORD also will be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble. And they that know thy name will put their trust in thee: for thou, LORD, hast not forsaken them that seek thee.**

Psalms 27:5: **For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon a rock.**

Psalms 46:1-3: **God *is* our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore will not we fear, though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea; *Though* the waters thereof roar *and* be troubled, *though* the mountains shake with the swelling thereof.**

Psalms 71:1, 5: **In thee, O LORD, do I put my trust: let me never be put to confusion. For thou *art* my hope, O Lord GOD: *thou art* my trust from my youth. Psalm 91:2 I will say of the LORD, *He is* my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.**

Psalms 91:14, 15: **Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name. He shall call upon me, and I will**

answer him: I *will be* with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him. Psalm 118:6 The LORD *is* on my side; I will not fear: what can man do unto me?

Psalm 107:6, 7: Then they cried unto the LORD in their trouble, *and* he delivered them out of their distresses. And he led them forth by the right way, that they might go to a city of habitation.

Psalm 138:7, 8: Though I walk in the midst of trouble, thou wilt revive me: thou shalt stretch forth thine hand against the wrath of mine enemies, and thy right hand shall save me. The LORD will perfect *that which* concerneth me: thy mercy, O LORD, *endureth* for ever: forsake not the works of thine own hands.

Proverbs 18:10: The name of the LORD *is* a strong tower: the righteous runneth into it, and is safe.

John 16:33: These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

Romans 8:31, 35, 37: What shall we then say to these things? If God *be* for us, who *can be* against us? Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? *shall* tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.

1 Corinthians 10:13: There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God *is* faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear *it*.

2 Timothy 4: 18: And the Lord shall deliver me from every evil work, and will preserve *me* unto his heavenly kingdom: to whom *be* glory for ever and ever. Amen.

Hebrews 13:5, 6: *Let your conversation be* without covetousness; *and be* content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. So that we may boldly say, The Lord *is* my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.
