

Believing God's Word for Your Healing and Prosperity

Dear Friend and Partner,

Isaiah 53:4,5: **Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.**

Matthew 8:17: **That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.**

1 Peter 2:24: **Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.**

These are promises that God gave us to let us know that not only did Jesus take our sins when He went to the cross, but He also took our sicknesses and diseases. Every day, I try to thank Jesus that He went to the cross for me. I usually say something like this:

Jesus, I want to thank You that You never yielded to temptation and never sinned. You were willing to go to the cross and give Your life for me so I could be saved and not go to hell. Thank You for writing my name in the **Lamb's Book of Life**.

Thank You, Jesus, that You bore my sicknesses and diseases, You took the curse of the law, and You became poor, that I might be rich.

Not only did You do it all for me, You did it for the whole world, and I just want to thank You for saving me, healing me, delivering me, forgiving me, and cleansing me.

I appreciate all You've done for me, Lord - all I'm aware of, as well as everything that I'm unaware of.

Everything Jesus did, He did for us. Everything Jesus did, He did for **you**. It's not God's will that you suffer any pain, or any sickness or any disease, or any poverty, or any lack.

Praising God and thanking God is one way for us to keep our faith active. In regards to healing, use Isaiah 53:4,5, as well as Matthew 8:17 and 1 Peter 2:24. Thank God throughout the day that by Jesus' stripes, you are healed.

Say something like this:

Father God, in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ,
I believe Your Word.

And Your Word says Jesus Himself took my infirmities,
bare my sicknesses, and by His stripes, I am healed.

And I want to thank You, Lord, that according to Your Word, I am healed!

Jesus came that we might have life, and have it more abundantly. He wishes that above all things we prosper and be in health. It's not God's will that we live in any kind of financial lack. He never wants us to run out of money. He always wants us to live in abundance.

Any time any doubt or unbelief comes to you, find promises in God's Word that help give you peace and reassurance that it's God's will that you have good health. I'll take a verse of scripture and just keep saying it to myself over and over again, because I'm reminding myself of what God wants me to have, and doing that is very helpful. God gave us His Word, and His Word never fails.

Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away. Matthew 24:35

So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it. Isaiah 55:11

Blessed be the LORD, that hath given rest unto his people ... according to all that he promised: there hath not failed one word of all his good promise... 1 Kings 8:56

If it's a financial situation that you're faced with, you can say something like this:

Father God, in Jesus' Name, I believe Your Word, and Your Word says that You wish above all things that I prosper. You promised You'd supply all of my need according to Your riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

For You know through the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for my sake, He became poor, that I through His poverty might be rich. The Lord is my Shepherd, I shall not want. Thank You Father God, for taking care of all my bills in Jesus' Name!

By doing this, it will help reassure you that God is your Father, Jesus is your Lord, and you're thanking God for what His Word says and what Jesus has purchased for you. At the same time, saying something like this is reminding you of what the Word says about you.

God will get you through whatever problem you're faced with, and He will get you through every problem that you'll ever face, because He loves you affectionately! **Casting the whole of your care [all your anxieties, all your worries, all your concerns, once and for all] on Him, for He cares for you affectionately and cares about you watchfully.** 1 Peter 5:7 AMP

So, whether it's healing, or finances or any other problem situation, find scriptures that cover it and thank God for His promises and that you are what His Word says you are, in Jesus' Name.
